## Introduction

Youth and Memory Engagement is a European gathering of young people actively involved in promoting democratic memory. Co-organized by the Youth Institute (Injuve) under the Ministry of Youth and Children, the European Observatory on Memories (EUROM) of the UB Solidarity Foundation, and the Spanish Commissioner Spain in Liberty. 50 Years, the event brings together 20 youth delegations from 19 countries in Barcelona to discuss the role of young people in shaping a shared European memory culture.

The meeting serves as a platform for exchanging experiences, best practices, and collaborative strategies among transnational memory initiatives.
