## XI WAITER BEN IAMIN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

Over the past decade, political and cultural discussions have been shaped by the upsurge and consolidation of various radical right and far-right movements worldwide. Against this backdrop, debates on the origins and features of the crisis of liberal democracy and the emergence of authoritarian political forces are ubiquitous, and they are often presented in the public sphere as the heirs of historical fascisms and the tumultuous 1920s and 1930s. The proposals of these political movements and regimes, with their leaders at the forefront, have in common simplification of political discourses, schematisation of public debate and advocacy of direct and forceful solutions to complex problems.

This is a global issue which concerns almost all liberal democratic countries, each with its own features related to its history or political and economic context. It ranges from the United States, Hungary, Italy, Germany, Austria and Spain to Argentina, Brazil, Venezuela, El Salvador, Turkey and India, to name but a few of those which are seeing these rising authoritarian tendencies. It is a widespread trend with crossborder components which is suitably tailored to local circumstances and expanding with unforeseeable consequences.

This international conference seeks to unpack the current crisis of liberal democracy through the interventions of specialists, taking into account all these factors and with a cross-cutting approach spanning political science, history, philosophy and journalism. It will also examine these political issues of the radical right and the farright in relation to the role which the conventional media, social media, education, political systems and public policies on memory can play.
